## **Glencoe Township Tiling & Culvert Installation Specifications**

Any person wishing to place culverts or drain tile under any township road shall be required to first seek approval from the supervisors of Glencoe Township. Such approval will depend on conditions which will be laid out in this document.

- 1. Any digging up of township road will be pre-approved by the supervisors. The landowner will provide their respective contractor a copy of these specifications so there can be no confusion as to the end result.
- Following installation of said tile or culverts, the road shall be required to be rebuilt to its previous condition. A spec sheet will be issued for the landowner and his/her contractor at the time of board approval.
- Landowner or their respective contractor shall be responsible for any related extra expenses due to their incorrect installation or road replacement procedures, if any deterioration occurs to said roadway for a period of 12 months.
- 4. If any culverts or tiling is to be done, steel culverts shall be required if placed less than 3 feet below field level, any depth greater than this, double wall plastic shall suffice. If installing through any township roads, culverts shall be dual wall plastic.
- 5. Any work being done shall require a licensed, bonded, and insured contractor.
- 6. The contractor shall be responsible for contacting 811 for locating any underground wires prior to any work being done.
